The Green Bay Packers are the third-oldest franchise in the National Football League. They were organized in 1919 by “Curly” Lambeau and George Calhoun. The Packers are the only non-profit, community-owned major league professional sports team in the United States.

The Packers have won 13 league championships (more than any other team in the NFL). They have four Super Bowl wins. In 1967 they beat the Chiefs, in 1968 they defeated the Raiders, in 1997 they won against the Patriots, and in 2011 they beat the Steelers.

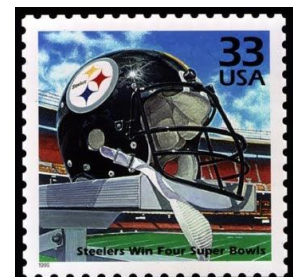


Vince Lombardi's coaching helped the Packers win Super Bowls I and II.
