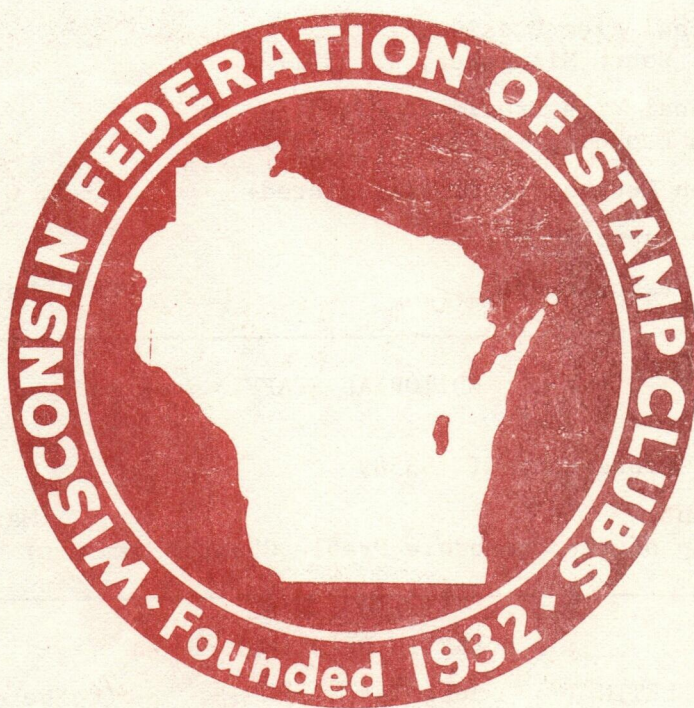

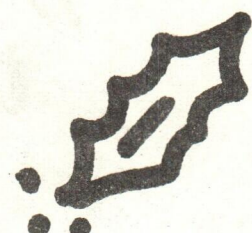
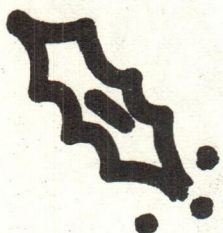

WISCONSIN FEDERATION OF STAMP CLUBS
EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE MEETING

October 23, 1976
Lake Geneva, WI

Meeting was called to order at 4:00 p.m. by President Owen Davidson. The following officers responded to the roll call: Owen Davidson (President), Carl Skupski (Vice President), John Taddy (Secretary-Treasurer), Daniel Rhoades (S.E. Regional Vice President), Roy Northwood (Central Regional Vice President), and Howard Sherpe (S.W. Regional Vice President). John Raney II (East Central Regional Vice President) and Les Topel (Northern Regional Vice President) did not attend.

Items of business were as follows:

I. Convention Sites

Officers moved to accept with thanks the bid of the Outagamie Philatelic Society to hold the 46th Annual Convention and Exhibition at the Embassy Motor Inn, Appleton, on May 14 & 15, 1977. Passed unanimously.

Officers moved to accept the bid of the Wisconsin Valley Philatelic Society to hold the 47th Annual Convention and Exhibition at the Holiday Inn, Wausau, on April 29 & 30, 1978. Passed unanimously.

Officers moved to establish the policy that WFSC accept bids up to three years in advance for future conventions. Bids for the 1979 and 1980 Conventions will be accepted at the 1977 Convention. Passed unanimously.

II. Stamp Show Date Conflicts

Officers moved that WFSC establish a Clearing House of show dates through the office of the Secretary-Treasurer and that member clubs contact him prior to setting dates for their show to avert conflicts in the future. He will also mail a listing of shows on a regular basis, usually monthly, to all member clubs. Passed unanimously. [See pages 37 & 39].

III. Hall of Fame Selection Procedure

After discussion of a proposal written by the three state-wide officers at a previous meeting, Officers moved to accept the Procedure as modified, and to submit it to a vote of the member clubs as specified. Passed unanimously. [See page 40].

Officers also moved to confirm the nominations of Daniel Rhoades (1 year term), Frank Moertl (2 year term), and Leon Christianson (3 year term, chairman) to the Hall of Fame Committee upon the approval of the Procedure by the member clubs, with the first term expiring at the 1978 Convention. Passed unanimously.

IV. Other Business

Officers decided to table the Realignment of Member Clubs for Regional Vice President purposes until the next meeting of the Executive Committee.

Officers moved to clarify the terms and members to the WFSC Standing Committee on Exhibitions: Vern Witt (through the 1977 Convention), Frank Jenich (through the 1978 Convention), and E.C. Lawrence, chairman (through the 1979 Convention).

WFSC BULLETIN Editor Phil Rose announced that the deadline for the Fall issue, starting in 1977 would be September 1 instead of October 1, in order to properly publicize the fall shows.

It was learned that Wisconsin Chapter #5^V has proposed a Constitutional

Amendment limiting a person to one delegate vote at the annual Conventions. Upon the written second of another member club, the amendment will be circulated for a vote. [See page 42].

Officers moved to make a \$10.00 donation to the Church of the Holy Communion, Lake Geneva, for the use of their Guild Hall for the Fall Meeting. Passed unanimously.

Officers were in general agreement over the success of the first Fall Meeting Seminar, and suggested that the 1977 session should be devoted to the topic of stamp show judging.

Officers scheduled another Executive Committee meeting to be held Saturday, March 5, 1977 in Milwaukee, WI in conjunction with MILCOPEX'77 at the Ramada Inn - South (New location of MILCOPEX'77. Exact time and place will be announced later with the Secretary-Treasurer sending notification to all Officers at an appropriate date.

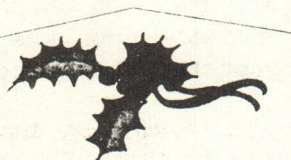

STAMP SHOW DATE CLEARING HOUSE

The WFSC recognizes that stamp shows are a fine way for collectors to publicize the hobby among the general public and provide an opportunity for collectors to renew old friendships and create new ones. When a conflict of show dates results, especially among clubs within a short distance of each other, ill will is created among clubs and collectors do not have this opportunity to fraternize among themselves.

Therefore, the WFSC has set up this Clearing House of Stamp Show Dates. It should be emphasized that this Clearing House will not have the authority to force a club to avoid a conflict, but will help prevent the simultaneous planning of two shows on the same weekend.

- A. All clubs should try to schedule their shows at least 9 to 12 months in advance--a longer time period is even better. It's a good idea to list next year's dates in this year's show program!

- B. Before a club has signed a firm contract for dates, the Secretary-Treasurer should be contacted for conflicts

- C. When dates are confirmed, they should be sent to the Secretary-Treasurer for listing on the Master Show Calendar, which will appear in the WFSC BULLETIN and also mailed to all member clubs, usually on a monthly basis.

Clubs should also take it upon themselves to publicize their show, not only through the WFSC BULLETIN, but in press releases issued as soon as your show dates are confirmed to member clubs, clubs in the surrounding areas, and the philatelic press.

Your Officers strongly urge the use of the Clearing House!

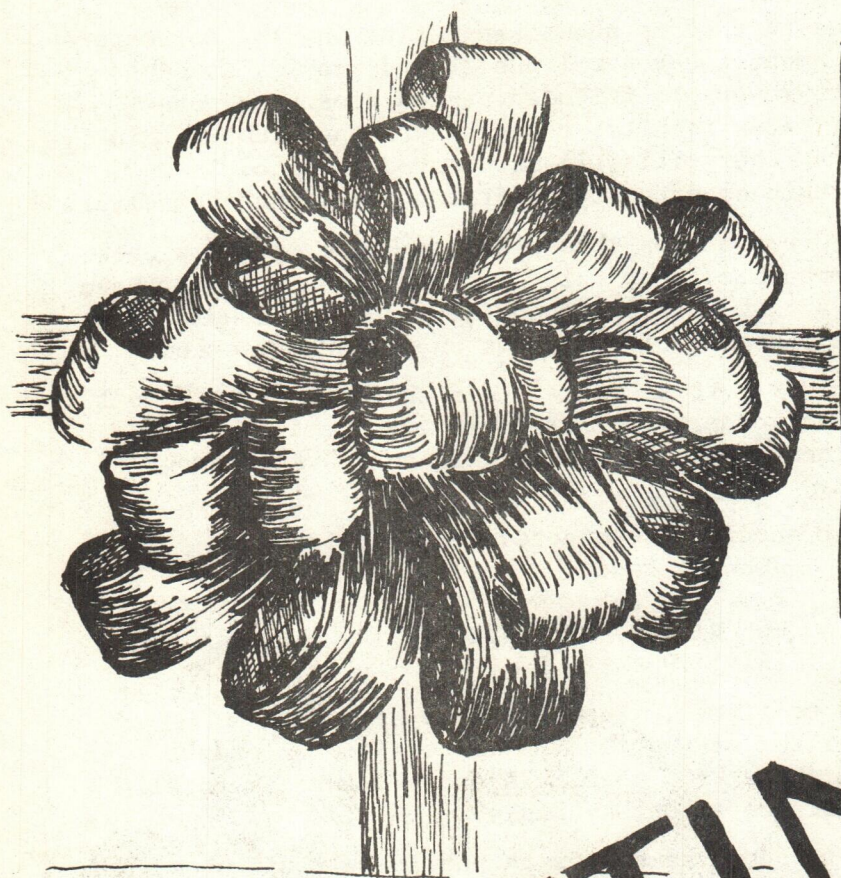
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NEW SITE ANNOUNCED FOR AMPHEX '77

1. Each nominee must be nominated by at least 3 member clubs. (A nomination is a statement of who the nominee is, a short biography, and the reasons for which that person should be selected to the Wisconsin Philatelic Hall of Fame).
2. All nominations must be sent to the Secretary-Treasurer to arrive by January 1 of the Convention Year (for 1977, the deadline shall be February 15).
3. All nominees shall be reviewed by a Hall of Fame Committee who will screen nominees down to the number specified by the WFSC Member Clubs. The Hall of Fame Committee will be made up of three distinguished and active philatelists who will serve alternating three year terms (the first Committee will be made up of members serving one, two, and three year terms, with the first term expiring at the 1978 Convention). The senior member of the Committee shall serve as Chairman. The President, with the consent of the member clubs, shall appoint members of the Committee and serve as an ex-officio member.
4. The following two qualifications will be required of all nominees:
 - A. Contributions of a purely local club nature shall not be the sole reason for selection to the Hall of Fame.
 - B. Starting with the 1978 Convention Year, a deceased philatelist may not be nominated or considered for selection until three years after his/her death.
5. Not more than three persons shall be selected to the Hall of Fame in each Convention Year.
6. Those inducted into the Hall of Fame (or a close relative, friend, or other person designated by the inductee or his surviving family) shall be honored at the following year's Convention Banquet, where a Certificate shall be presented.
7. This Procedure may be amended by a vote of the majority of member clubs voting at any Convention or Special Meeting, or by a majority of member clubs by a mail vote.

This Procedure shall be approved by written vote of a majority of member clubs within 60 days of mailing.

The R.P.S. is busily promoting its philatelic Christmas card sale.

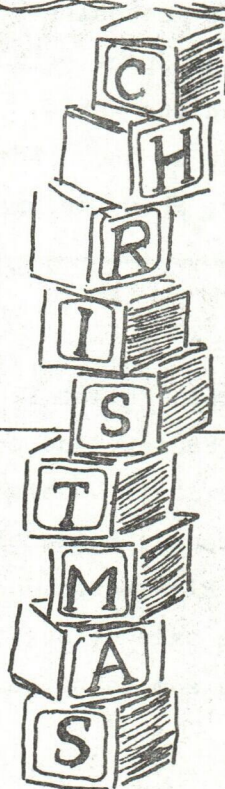
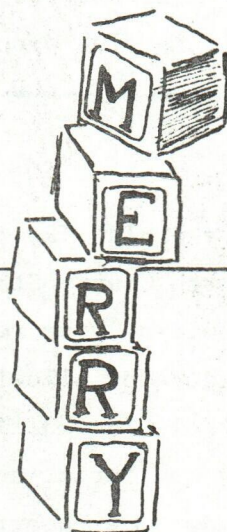

NOTICE OF AMENDMENT

The Wisconsin Chapter #5, ATA has presented an amendment to the Constitution of the Wisconsin Federation of Stamp Clubs which would limit a person to one delegate vote at a Federation Convention's Business Session.

The Amendment will add a Section 3 to Article VI (Meetings), and will read as follows:

"Each representative at an Annual Meeting shall be limited to the delegate credentials of one club at that Annual Meeting."

For approval of this amendment, two-thirds of the Member Clubs (24 of 35) must vote in favor of this amendment within 60 days of its presentation to member clubs.

Votes must be received no later than January 7, 1977.

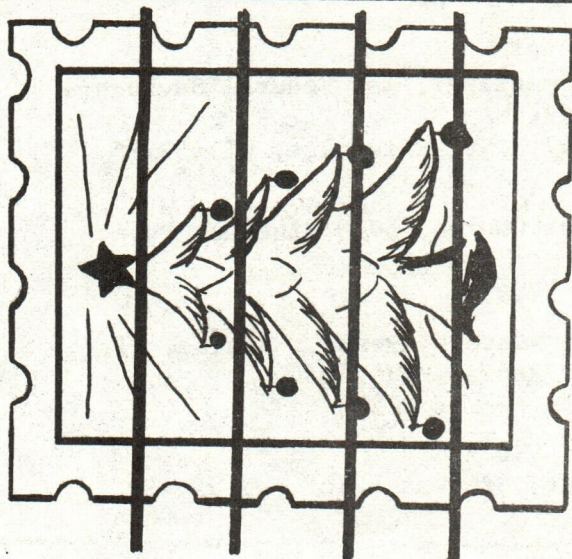
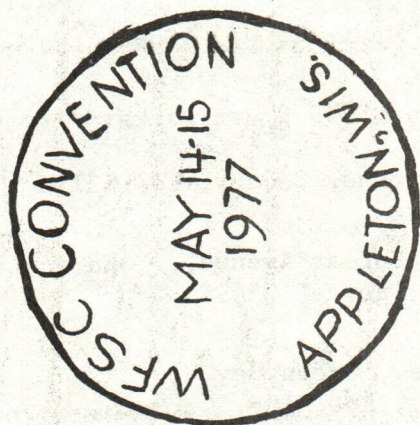
SHOW NEWS

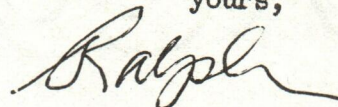
Dear Phil,

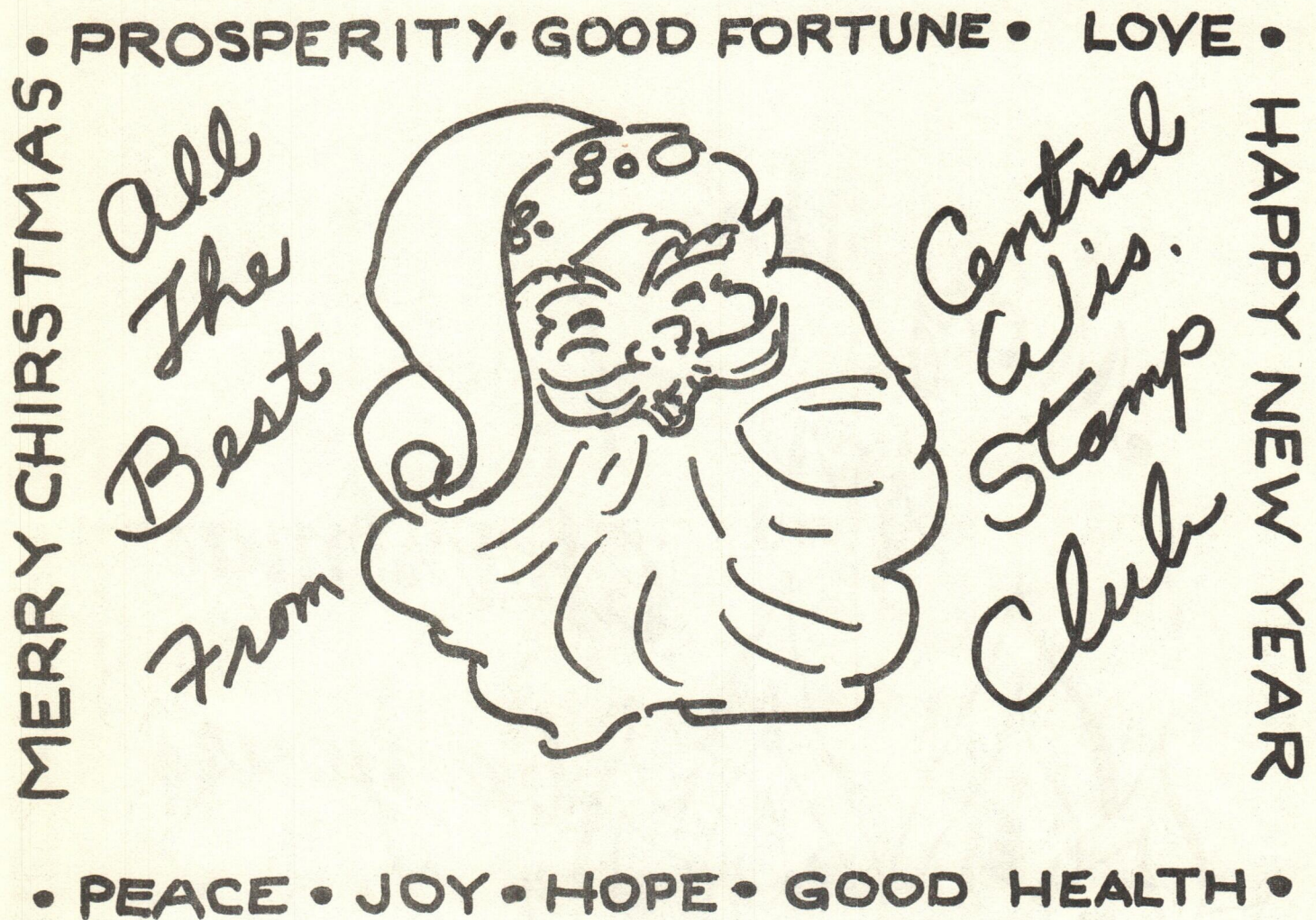
